LEVEL 5/6 APP LIST FOR iPADS AND TABLETS 2018



Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of the Level 5/6 curriculum and 1:1 BYO Device program we would like all of our students to have access to a range of resources to support their learning. Attached is a list of apps that we ask you to download for use on student iPads. Although we continue to look for cheap (preferably free) apps that enhance your child's education, there are a few apps we consider essential that do incur a small charge.

The apps are divided into three categories. 'Essential Apps' are those we expect all students to access. 'Optional Apps' are useful for school and/or home, but we will not set activities based on these. The last category is 'Optional Paid Homework Apps' - these apps are definitely not required for school but are listed for parents looking for extra options. Apps in all three categories may be useful for homework, but iPads are never required to complete homework tasks.

A few apps on the list are iPhone apps so if you can't find them, search under *iPhone Only* (they still work). Some apps are cross-platform (i.e. available on non-Apple devices) - including the Google apps - however this is not always the case. If you have an Android or Windows based tablet, please look for a suitable replacement app that fulfils the same functionality. We do understand however that this may not be possible for all listed apps, particularly the maths ones.

Please note that a few apps offer in-app purchases or include ads; you will need to ensure that no credit card details are stored on the iPad and that your iPad settings require a password for purchases and downloads. This password should be for parent use only. If you are unsure of how to do this, please ask your child's teacher. While all the apps are rated appropriately, some optional apps contain cartoon style violence.

Later in the year students will be given the opportunity to read eBooks on their iPads. This will only be available through the Eastern Regional Library via the Overdrive app (listed on the following page); more details about signing up to this library service will be forwarded at a later date.

Throughout the year we may supplement this list with additional apps for specific purposes as they become available or we determine a need or opportunity. As a general rule, all apps should be downloaded at home, however if you are having any difficulties with this, please contact your child's teacher.

OPTIONAL Paid Homework Apps for Maths

IT IS NOT NECESSARY to buy ANY apps for homework, or to use iPads for homework at all. However the paid maths apps listed below get good reviews from a variety of sources and may assist in motivating students. Try the apps above first, then consider these apps only if you are looking for something more. Some have limited free versions to try.

Note that these apps have been researched but not personally tested by us. 'Teaching' tutorials / videos are included in some apps, but are probably best avoided as they may not fit with the way that we teach concepts, and this may create confusion.
